Our Testimony

This ministry was started by my father in 1951 with ten people in 10'x10' room. He was a pastor and working among the telgu as well as non believers, he started doing by house visiting, and preaching the gospel. Then God helped in many ways in finance and in all ways. We have completed a 4000 sqft, building to accommodate our people who are 250 strong in our services. Our children's ministries have now over 1200 children in it. We train helpers to work with our children. We also teach sewing classes to the women in our area to help them make a living for themselves and families these classes are open to all.

We also have a Bible School to train Pastors to go out in the villages to preach the Gospel to those in need. It is a two year program where the student comes and studies for three months then is sent into the field for three months then comes back for another three months this goes on for two years. We have graduated 250 students from our school. There have been 11 churches started from those.

STATEMENT OF BELIEFS

- 1. We Believe: The Bible to be the inspired, infallible, Word of God. It is the ultimate authority in all manner of faith and life.**
- 2. We Believe: There is one God who exists eternally, who's the creator of all things, that He is Triune in the Father, Son and Holy Spirit.**
- 3. We Believe: Jesus Christ is God's only begotten Son, who is God and human at the same time. He was born of a virgin, conceived by the Holy Spirit of God. 5. We Believe: That men are saved through confession of the mouth and heart that God Raised Jesus Christ from the dead. (Romans 10: 9-10). Which leads to repentance of sin therefore surrendering to God completely through the power of the Holy Spirit?

6. We Believe: In the present ministry of the Holy Spirit. Those believers after confession of sins and being yielded to the power of the Holy Spirit are Baptized and endued power from on high the evidence is the speaking in tongues. That the Holy Spirit through men still produce miraculous gifts in divine healing, Prophecy, words of knowledge, discernment of the spirit, power to raise the dead. Which we have been eyewitnesses to many times. The Holy Spirit gives to us a victorious life today.

7. We Believe: in the rapture (snatching away) of the church or the catching away of believers to meet Jesus Christ in the air.

8. We Believe: in the second coming of Jesus Christ to earth to rule for a thousand years with His bride the church.

9. We Believe: in the bodily resurrection of the dead; believers to eternal life, unbelievers to eternal damnation.

10. We Believe: in the Judgment seat of Christ which all believers will have to stand before to give an account of their earthly life.

11. We Believe: every sinner will stand before God at the Great White Throne Judgment to give account of their deeds as recorded in the book. Those whose names are not found in the book of life will be cast into the Lake of Fire forever.
